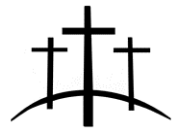

Property Committee Update

1. The 2 new handrails are installed.
2. The church voted to spend up to \$8,000 to remodel the nursery area and install at least part of the flooring in the downstairs on 8/29/21. This work is scheduled to begin about September 28th.
3. The playground work should begin in the next 2-3 weeks.
4. Conversations continue regarding the rest of downstairs and upstairs remodeling that may be proposed in the coming months.
